Dr Richard Schloeffel is a registered general practitioner who is the Medical Director at The Grove Health Pymble. For the past 20 years Dr Schloeffel has been treating complex and chronic disorders, developing diagnostic and treatment protocols for disorders such as chronic fatigue syndrome (CFS), borreliosis and auto-immune diseases. Dr Schloeffel has treated over 3500 patients with CFS and related disorders. He is currently President of The Australian Chronic Infectious and Inflammatory Disease Society (ACIIDS) and is assisting with the Tick-borne Disease Unit at Sydney University. In 2017, he was awarded the Order of Australia Medal (OAM) for his work in Chronic and Infectious Diseases.

Dr Sandeep Gupta is a registered general practitioner who runs an integrative medicine clinic on Queensland's Sunshine Coast. His range of medical interests include environmental medicine, mast cell activation syndrome, multiple chemical sensitivity and management of chronic disease. Dr Gupta was awarded a Fellowship of the Australasian College of Nutritional and Environmental Medicine in 2008 and a Fellowship of the Australian College of General Practitioners in 2010. He has physician training certification in biotoxin illness and a Masters of Nutrition in diabetes and living food nutrition. He is a board member of the Australian Chronic Infectious and Inflammatory Disease Society (ACIIDS) and the International Society for Environmentally Acquired Illness (ISEAI).
